## Earth Night - Protect the environment, and eat it too!

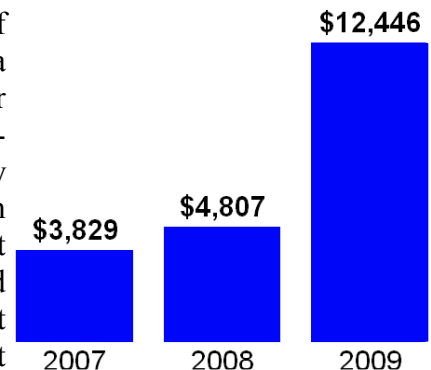
*Friday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 7-9pm, Cafeteria & Amphitheater*

After that, the Blake community gave tremendously through classroom donations and participating in restaurant nights, the Bengal Ball tournament, and Dance for a Chance (the school's first winter dance). For having the largest annual increase in the county, Blake



earned the Most Valuable Player award. Also, Blake was among the top 20 most generous participants in the country.
